



GLL eLearning Course Honors Requirements are as follows:

To be considered for graduation with honors, students are required to thoughtfully, thoroughly, and accurately complete all curriculum and practicum assignments; and present them on time in a manner of excellence.

Students must also perform the following to be considered for graduation with honors:

1. Complete 20 hours of volunteer community service, which includes, but is not limited to women's shelters, community food banks, nursing homes, community clean up events. To show proof of the Community Service Event, please print, complete, scan and submit the Community Service Event Form provided with this course. Or, you may submit a letter from the ministry or facility leader showing proof of the Community Service Event. Be sure to include your name, date of service, arrival & departure times, and name of ministry or organization. Email Proof of Community Service Event to [gll@tdjakes.org](mailto:gll@tdjakes.org).
2. Completion of 1 ½ page essay of your GLL experience. Email essay to [gll@tdjakes.org](mailto:gll@tdjakes.org).
3. Recite from memory, the past recipients of the GLL Legacy Lady Award, and the year it was received by each recipient. Recitation will include award winners from 2003-2016. Recitation will be done via voice message by calling 214.623.4102. Integrity is paramount. In the voice message, please include your name, contact number, and a statement that the recitation was not read, but recited from memory.
